Sewerage and Water Board crews and the Department of Public Works contractor, Hard Rock Construction, will perform a waterline repair and water valve replacement in the Gentilly/Fairgrounds area. One lane of traffic will be closed at the intersection of Gentilly Boulevard and Castiglione Street while work is in progress.

Residents and businesses on several streets in the Gentilly/Fairgrounds area will experience low water pressure on Monday, February 6, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
