Sewerage and Water Board is alerting residents and businesses in the French Quarter that a private contractor working in the area broke a 12" water main this evening in the 200 block of Bourbon Street. Crews have secured the area and will make repairs to the main beginning at 8am in the morning.

Residents and businesses on Bourbon Street will experience low water pressure on Wednesday morning, August 10, 2016 beginning at 8am until the repair is completed.
