Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will be cutting and capping a water line that will serve the area.

Residents and businesses on Camp Street between Amelia Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street area will experience low water pressure on Friday, July 29, 2016 at 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. This work is part of the \$82.6 million SELA Louisiana Avenue Canal Project.
