## **We're improving your water system- Coliseum Street**

Residents and businesses on Coliseum Street between Louisiana Avenue and Amelia Street will experience low water pressure on Thursday, January 21, 2016 from 5 p.m. until 12 a.m., midnight.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of an 8" water line to an existing line that services the area. This work is part of the \$82.6 million Louisiana Avenue Canal, SELA Urban Flood Improvement Program.
