We're Improving Your Water System- Dumaine Street

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of an 8" water main that services the area.

Residents and businesses in the French Quarter Area will experience low water pressure on Thursday night, June 9, 2016 from 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. on Friday morning, June 10, 2016. This work is part of the \$188 million FEMA funded waterline replacement project.
