Sewerage and Water Board crews will be making repairs to a large water main.

Residents and businesses in the Uptown Area, French Quarter, CBD and Warehouse District will experience low water pressure overnight beginning Tuesday, April 12, 2016 at 7 p.m. to 4 a.m. on Wednesday, April 13th.

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

The two riverbound traffic lanes will be closed at Earhart and Freret Street. Traffic will be diverted onto the far right lane traveling westbound to avoid the work zone. All traffic will be normal from Earhart at S. Liberty traveling westbound.
