Weather dependent, Cajun Construction, working for the Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board will perform roadway striping that will affect traffic flow and parking.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Prytania Street from Jefferson Avenue to Nashville Avenue will be closed to day and evening parking.
