Weather dependent, Cajun Construction, working for the Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board **will perform roadway striping that will affect traffic flow and parking.**

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Prytania Street from Jefferson Avenue to Nashville Avenue will be closed to day and evening parking. The work is expected to begin at 7 a.m. on Monday, September 26, 2015 through Wednesday, September 28, 2016 at 5 p.m. No-parking signs and detour signs will be in place.
