We're Improving Your Drainage System – Traffic Advisory – Eads Street

Renda-J Brothers-JV, working for the Corps of Engineers and Sewerage and Water Board, will **perform drainage system work that will affect traffic flow on Eads Street for three weeks.**

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Eads Street from Law Street to Florida Avenue will be closed to traffic for **three weeks beginning on Wednesday, December 13, 2017. No parking of personal vehicles will be permitted within the work zone.** This work is part of the \$147.5 million SELA Florida Avenue Drainage Canal Improvement Project.
