We're Improving Your Drainage System - Traffic Advisory - Eads Street

Renda-J Brothers-JV, working for the Corps of Engineers and Sewerage and Water Board, will perform drainage system work that will affect traffic flow on Eads Street for three weeks.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Eads Street from Law Street to Florida Avenue will be closed to traffic for **three weeks beginning on Wednesday, December 13, 2017. No parking of personal vehicles will be permitted within the work zone.** This work is part of the \$147.5 million SELA Florida Avenue Drainage Canal Improvement Project.


