We're improving your sewer system - Traffic Advisory - Paris Avenue

Wallace C. Drennan Contractors, working for Sewerage and Water Board will perform sewer system work that will affect traffic flow on Paris Avenue.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that the intersection of Paris Avenue and Prentiss Avenue will have lane closures for approximately three weeks beginning **Monday**, **March 13**th **through Friday**, **March 31**, **2017**. The southbound lanes of Paris Avenue from Prentiss Avenue to Crescent Street will have two-way traffic until work is completed. Traffic controls will be in place.
