We're Improving Your Water and Drainage Systems - Upper and Lower Ninth Ward

Sewerage and Water Board is improving your water system. Crews will perform a test on a 48 inch waterline that serves the Upper and Lower Ninth Ward.

Residents and businesses on Florida Avenue from Franklin Avenue to Alvar Street and residents of the Lower Ninth Ward may experience low water pressure on **Wednesday**, **October 12**, **2016 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.** Persons experiencing low pressure while this work is being performed are asked to notify us at 52-WATER(529-2837) so that we can attempt to adjust your pressure.

This work is part of the \$119 million SELA Florida Avenue Canal Phase 2-3 Drainage Project.

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure.
