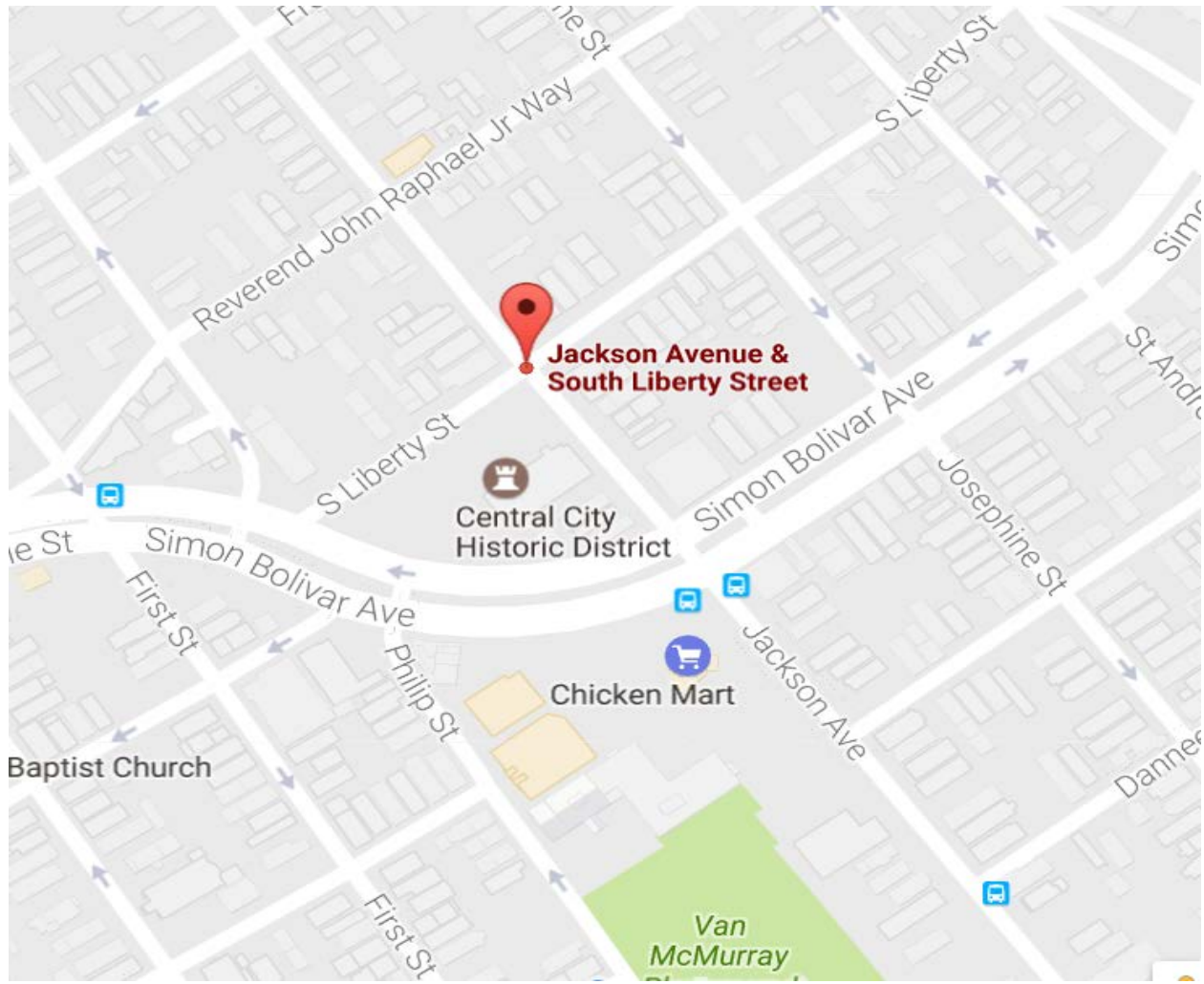
Northbound traffic will be detoured to Simon Bolivar – Martin Luther King – S. Claiborne Avenue
