Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing a series of water line repairs on Saturday, November 11th and Sunday November 12th, 2017.

Residents and businesses on several streets in the Algiers Area may experience low water pressure on Saturday, Nov. 11th from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The westbound side of Opelousas Avenue from Nunez Street to Verrett will be closed to traffic on Sunday, Nov 12th from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. A traffic detour will be in place.


