The Sewerage and Water Board and Corps of Engineers are performing waterline work in your area. B&K Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board and Corps of Engineers, will be installing a new waterline. This work is part of the \$46.2 million, Phase II SELA Jefferson Avenue Urban Flood Improvement Project.
