We're improving your water system - Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory **Uptown, French Quarter, CBD, and Warehouse District**

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that customers in parts of the Uptown Area, French Quarter, CBD, and Warehouse District, will experience low water pressure on Monday February 22, 2016 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Sewerage and Water Board crews will be making assessments to repair a valve on a 30" water main.

Traffic Advisory

Due to the valve assessment work at Earhart and Magnolia, the right travel lane westbound will be closed. Motorists are advised that a right turn onto Earhart Boulevard from Magnolia Street will not be allowed while work is in progress. All traffic will be advised to turn right on Earhart Boulevard from Clio Street.
