Sewerage and Water Board is improving your water system. Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board and the Corps of Engineers, will perform work to tie-in a large water main that serves the Lower Ninth Ward.

Residents and businesses in the Lower Ninth Ward are not expected to experience low water pressure during the work that will start at 4 p.m., Friday, October 21, 2016 until 4 p.m., Sunday, October 23, 2016.
