We're Improving Your Water System – **Emergency Repair** - N. Broad Street

Wallace C. Drennan Company, working for Sewerage and Water Board, will **perform emergency** waterline work on Friday, December 1, 2017 that will also affect traffic flow.

Residents and businesses on the lakeside of N. Broad Street from Toulouse Street to St. Philip Street will experience low water pressure on tomorrow, **December 1**st. from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Both lake bound lanes on Orleans Avenue will be closed at the intersection of N. Broad Street while work is in progress. Traffic detours will be in place.


