We're improving your water system – Traffic Advisory – S. Claiborne Avenue

The Sewerage and Water Board is improving your water system. Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will perform roadway restoration that will affect traffic flow on two days next week. This work is part of the \$188 million FEMA Funded-Waterline Replacement Program.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that the S. Claiborne Avenue Overpass-eastbound down ramp exit at Gravier Street will be closed to traffic on Monday, October 10, 2016 beginning at 7 p.m. through Tuesday morning, October 11, 2016 at 5 a.m. and then again on Tuesday night at 7 p.m. through Wednesday morning, October 12, 2016 at 5 a.m.
