The Sewerage and Water Board will be performing water line work. Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will be performing a tie-in of a water main that services the area.


Residents and businesses in the Uptown Area may experience low water pressure on Thursday, December 1, 2016 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work is part of the \$55.1 million Napoleon Avenue Canal Phase III, SELA Urban Flood Improvement Program.
