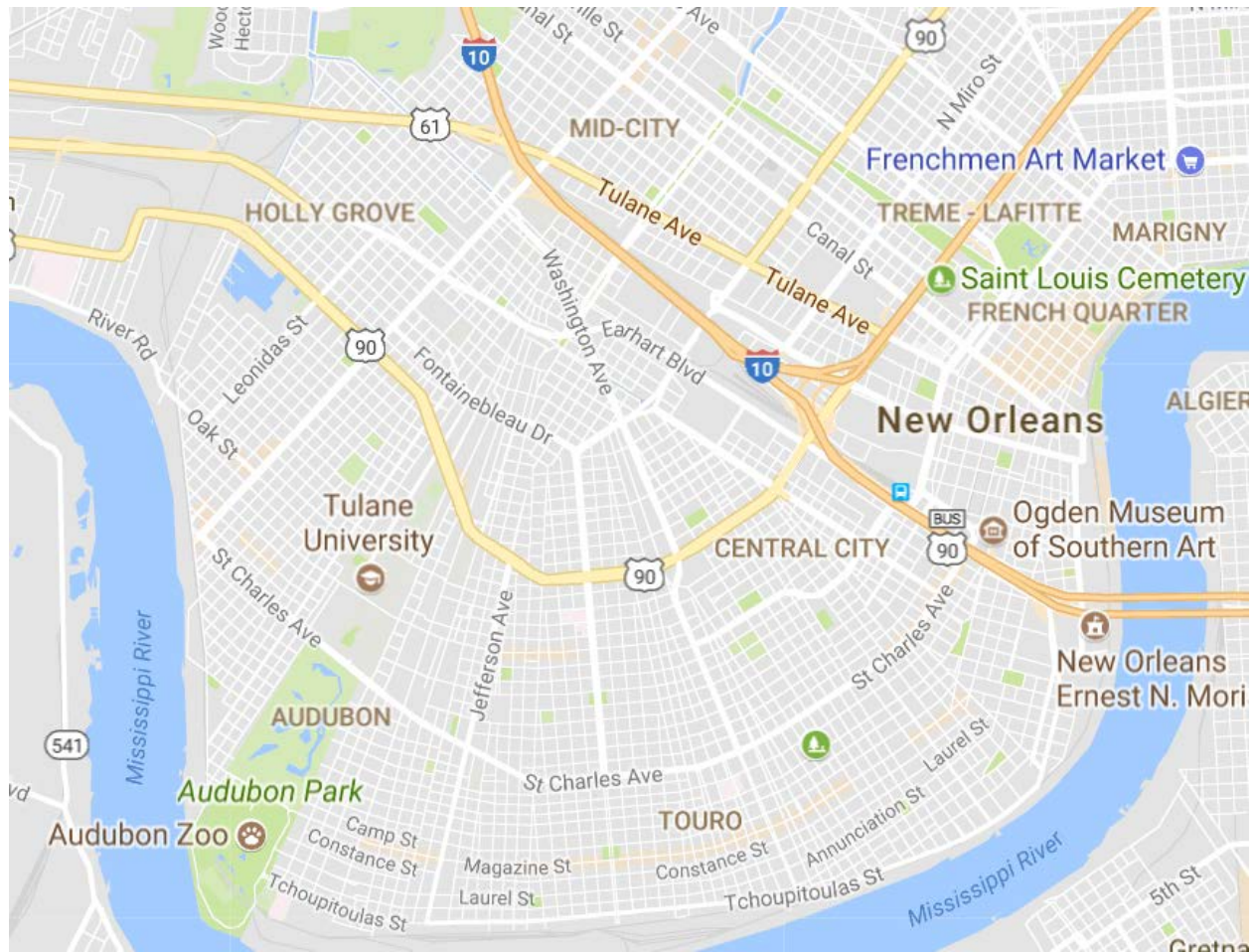
The areas affected are bounded by:
