Wallace Drennan Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board will perform final restoration of Washington Avenue following waterline work.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Washington Avenue between Magazine Street and Constance Street will be closed to vehicular traffic over the week end beginning on Friday, May 13, 2016 at 6 p.m. through Monday, May 16, 2016 at 6 a.m.

The following detour will be in place:

Lake bound traffic on Washington Avenue will be detoured at Tchoupitoulas Street to Jackson Avenue to Magazine Street. River bound traffic on Washington Avenue will be detoured to Magazine Street to Jackson Avenue.
