We're improving your water system - Traffic Advisory

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that vehicular traffic on several streets in the Uptown Area will be closed to vehicular traffic or re-routed on Saturday, February 13th and Sunday February 14th. Sewerage and Water Board crews will be repairing a series of valves on water lines in the area.

The streets affected are listed below:

Freret Street(Westbound lane) Napoleon Avenue Jena Street 6:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Freret Street (Westbound lane) Upperline Street Robert Street 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

There will be no access to Freret Street-westbound from Napoleon Avenue. Northbound traffic on Napoleon Avenue will be redirected to St. Charles Avenue. Southbound traffic on Napoleon Avenue will be redirected to S. Claiborne Avenue while work is in progress.
