## **S&WB Reports Rainfall Totals– Weather Advisory**

Sewerage and Water Board wants to inform customers that heavy thunderstorms today caused significant rainfall throughout various parts of the City. The rainfall recorded at 5 p.m. includes: Broadmoor- 4.94 inches, Mid City- 7.81 inches, St. Bernard- 5.42 inches, Gentilly- 2.76 inches, Lower Nine- 3.00 inches, Lakeview- 4.71 inches, City Park- 4.86 inches, Lower Coast Algiers- 1.33 inches, New Orleans East- .16 inches, St. Roch- 4.96 inches, and the Hollygrove area- 1.35 inches.

Sewerage and Water Board’s drainage pumping system is fully staffed and operational. The system is able to accommodate one inch of rain the first hour and half an inch of rain each hour after that.

Motorists are advised not to drive through flooded areas.
