Low Water Pressure – Common and Carondelet Street

Residents and businesses on Common Street between St. Charles Avenue and Carondelet Street and on Carondelet Street from Gravier Street to Canal Street will experience low water pressure overnight beginning at 10 p.m. on Monday, April 20 through 6 a.m., Tuesday, April 21, 2015.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will complete a tie-in of a new water line to serve the area, weather permitting.

This work is part of the \$183 million Sewerage and Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
