Sewerage and Water Board crews will perform a two-part water closure to repair valves on water lines in your area.

Residents and businesses in the City Park area will experience low water pressure on Thursday, July 21, 2016 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Motorists are also advised that the right lane of southbound traffic on Orleans Avenue between Conti Street and Moss Street will be closed to vehicular traffic while work is in progress.
