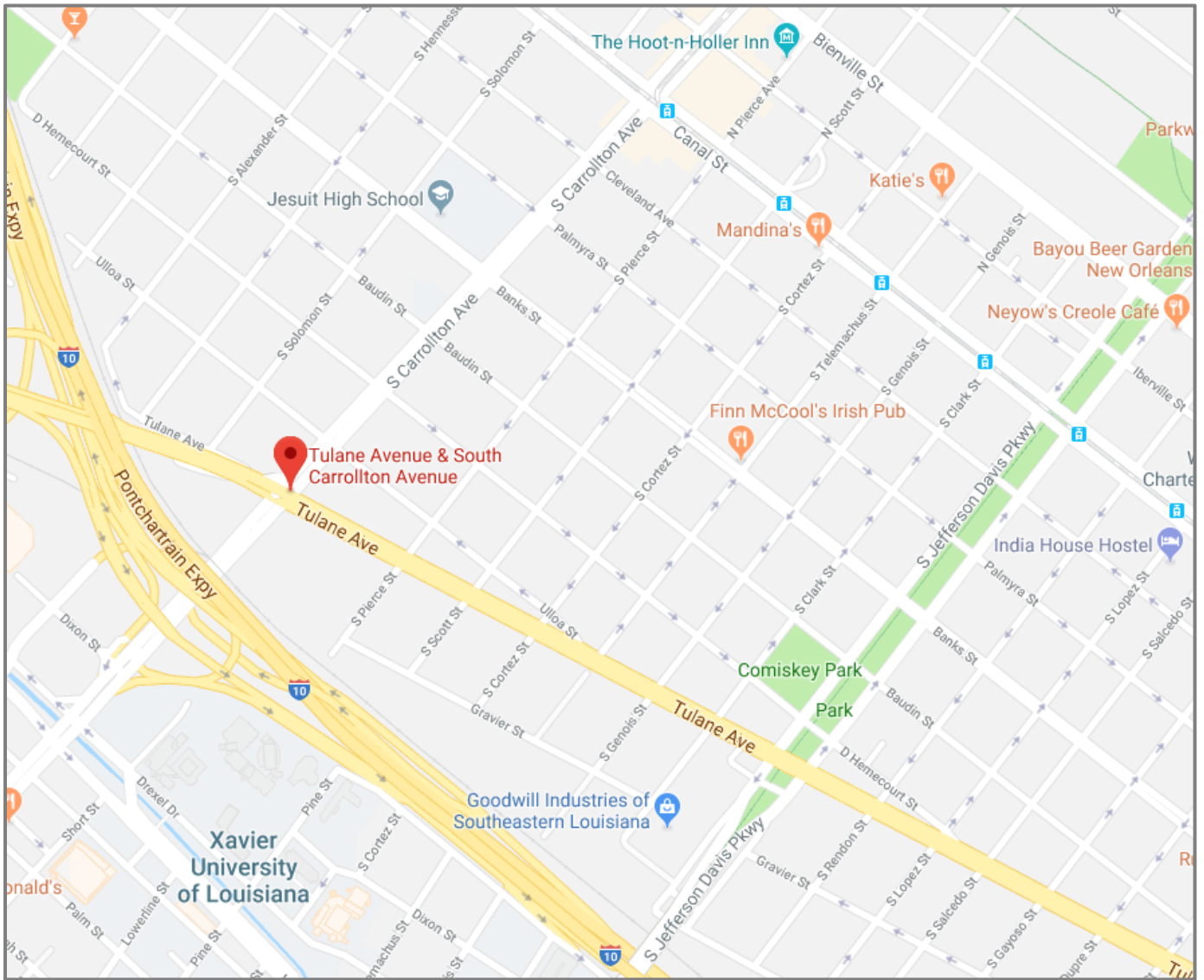
Traffic Advisory:
