Sewerage & Water Board Welcomes Three New Members

The Sewerage & Water Board of New Orleans has three new members, appointed to serve the unexpired terms of former members who resigned last year.

The appointees are Karen Henley-Raymond, representing Council District D, Dr. Gerald Williams and Alan C. Arnold, representing the Board of Liquidation, City Debt.

Henley-Raymond is with Johnson Controls, where she serves as Solutions Development Manager of Integrated Client Services for Higher Education. She is responsible for proposal development and coordination for subcontractors for higher education clients.

She holds a Masters of Business Administration from Tulane University's A. B. Freeman School, a Masters Degree in Public Health from Tulane and Bachelor of Science Degree in Industrial Engineering from the University of Tennessee.

She is past president of the local chapter of the International Facility Management Association, secretary of the Urban League of Greater New Orleans and a board member of the Contemporary Arts Center.

Her S&WB term will expire in October of 2009.

Dr. Williams is chief financial officer/vice-president for business and finance at Dillard University. He was formerly the vice chancellor for administration and finance at Southern University of New Orleans.

He began his career as a management/fiscal operations officer and proceeded through the level of president in corporate business and private enterprise.

In higher education, he began as student financial aid director and became comptroller at SUNO. Earlier he was executive assistant to the chancellor and was later appointed vice-president for administration and finance at SUNO.

He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Accounting from Southern University of New Orleans and a Masters of Science Degree in Management from Troy State University.

Williams is a member of the National Association of Colleges and University Business Office, the National Accounting Association and Sigma Beta Delta International Business Honorary Society.

Arnold, president of MidSouth Realty Management Inc. and Arnold & Co. Inc., is a former president of Howard, Weil, Labouisse, Friedrichs Inc. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree and a Masters of Business Administration from Loyola University.
