## **LOW WATER PRESSURE**

Residents and businesses in a part of New Orleans east will experience very low water pressure on Saturday and Sunday, March 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. while the Sewerage and Water Board repairs several fire hydrants that serve the area.
