## VERY LOW WATER PRESSURE

Residents and businesses in a small section of the Lower Ninth Ward will experience very low water pressure on Saturday and Sunday, January 22nd and 23rd, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days, while Sewerage and Water Board crews make repairs to a 24-inch water main that serves the area.

The area affected is Burgundy Street from Jordan Avenue to Tupelo Street.

The entire Lower 9<sup>th</sup> Ward may experience poor pressure as well.
