LOW WATER PRESSURE

Residents and businesses in a small area of Mid City will experience very low water pressure on tonight, Monday August 9, 2010 from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. while Wallace Drennen Construction Company working for the Sewerage and Water Board performs the second tie-in to a new water service at the V.A. hospital complex.

The area affected is on Canal Street from N. Tonti Street to N. Broad Street (both sides)

Also, Sewerage and Water Board crews will be repairing a valve on a 4" water line in the same area. The area affected is on Canal Street from N. Broad Street to N. Gayoso Street (both sides).
