LOW WATER PRESSURE IN TWO AREAS OF THE CITY

Residents and businesses in a small section of the French Quarter will experience very low water pressure on Saturday August 28, 2010 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. while Sewerage and Water Board crews make repairs to three water leaks on a 24" water main in the area.

The street affected are the 700, 1000, and 1100 blocks of Decatur Street.

Traffic will also be reduced to one-lane on Decatur Street WB from St. Philip to Gov. Nichols and from St. Peter to St. Ann Street.

Low Water Pressure

Residents in a small section of the Lower 9th Ward will experience low water pressure on Saturday and Sunday, August 28 and 29th from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. while crews repair a large water main at M. L. King Elementary School.

The area affected is on N. Derbigny Street from Andry to Lemanche Street.
