## LOW WATER PRESSURE

Residents and businesses in a section of New Orleans east may experience low water pressure on Thursday, September 24<sup>th</sup> from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. while a contractor working for the Corps of Engineers makes repairs to a valve on an 8-inch water line coming from a 50-inch water main associated with the Dwyer Road drainage canal project.

The area affected is bounded by France Road out to Venetian Isles and from Chef Menteur Highway to Haynes Boulevard.
