## **Electrical Problem Causes Water Pressure to Drop**

Several areas on the East Bank of New Orleans experienced lower-than normal water pressure tonight as a result of a problem at the electrical generating plant at the East Bank Water Treatment Plant.

Efforts were immediately undertaken to correct the problem.

The problem, which appears to be related to a turbine, occurred at or about 8:15 p.m. and was repaired by 9 p.m. Normal water pressure has been restored.
