Residents and businesses in a large portion of the city will experience very low water pressure on Saturday, June 26, 2010 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. while the Sewerage and Water Board makes repairs to a 12-inch water line connected to a 50-inch water main that serves the areas.

Areas affected:

On Republic Street from N. Rocheblave Street to Abundance Street

Duels Street from St. Bernard Avenue to Elysian Fields Avenue

The entire Lower 9th Ward

New Orleans East out to Venetian Isles
