LOW WATER PRESSURE

Residents and businesses in three sections of the city will experience lower than normal water pressure on Saturday and Sunday, September 19th and 20th from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. while the Sewerage and Water Board makes repairs to valves and water mains.

Saturday, September 19, 2009

Crews will be working to repair a valve on a 6" water main. The repair affects Chartres Street from Press St. to Clouet Street.

Sunday, September 20, 2009

Crews will be working to repair a leak on a 20" water main that serves the downtown area. The repair affects Perdido Street from Freret Street to South Rampart Street.

Crews will be working to repair a leak on a 20" water main in the Bywater area. The repair affects Royal Street from Press Street to Clouet Street.
