LOW WATER PRESSURE IN THE EAST; BOIL WATER ADVISORY CANCELLED

Residents and businesses in New Orleans east from Industrial Parkway to Venetian Isles will experience very low water pressure on Wednesday, June 16, 2010 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. while Wallace Drennen Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, replaces several fire hydrants on the water line that serves the area.

Customers in the affected areas were initially advised by the Sewerage and Water Board to boil water when water pressure was restored, but the advisory has been cancelled. Water will be safe for drinking, cooking bathing and other personal needs while the repairs are being done and after the work is completed.
