## **Sewerage and Water Board Names Deputy General Superintendent Madeline Fong Goddard**

Madeline Fong Goddard, P.E, has been named Deputy General Superintendent of the Sewerage & Water Board of New Orleans.

She will report to Joseph R. Becker, General Superintendent.

Goddard has served in various management positions with the City of Phoenix (Arizona) Water Services Department for the past 16 years. During the prior nine years of her career she has been a scientist, an engineering consultant, a contracting construction manager and a public health regulator in the water industry.

She was most recently water services superintendent for planning research and program management. In that capacity she developed and managed the Water and Wastewater Capital Improvement Program, which is more than \$1.6 billion for fiscal year 2006-2011.

Some other key positions she held were water services superintendent for water engineering and engineering supervisor of the city's engineering and architectural services department of the technical services division.

Through the work in these and other capacities she has accomplished what she describes as firsts for Phoenix, such as partnering on major construction projects, implementing a capital projects control system, constructing a desert "wetland" and designing a water reclamation facility.

Goddard earned a Masters of Science Degree in Sanitary Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology in 1979 and a Bachelors of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of California, Berkeley, in 1977.

She is active in the American Water Works Association (AWWA), serving on its Diversity and Membership Involvement Committee. She also serves on the Design Build Institute of America Water-Wastewater Conference Committee.

Goddard has been involved with numerous civic organizations in Phoenix.
